Roadway Construction Update

Ramp Road:

On Thursday, June 12, 2014, the Town of Canton will begin roadway improvements weather permitting, on Ramp Road from Powder Mill Road to the Transfer Station. The roadway improvements will include reclamation or reconstruction of the existing bituminous concrete pavement section, resurfacing of the roadway, curb replacement, and reconstruction of driveway aprons as required.

Construction activities will take place between 7 A. M. and 5 P. M., it is our hope to complete the repaving of Ramp Road weather permitting by June 20, 2014. We ask that no cars be parked in the road during the construction times mentioned above. The roadway will be open to local traffic at all times during construction. Residents using Ramp Road may experience delays during completion of the project. Detours signs will be provided during construction activities to reduce traffic congestion during construction.

Indian Hill Road:

On Saturday, June 14, 2014, the Town of Canton will begin roadway improvements weather permitting, on Indian Hill Road from Albany Turnpike to West Mountain Road. The roadway improvements will include a thin overlay of the existing bituminous concrete pavement section, and reconstruction of driveway aprons as required.

Construction activities will take place between 7 A. M. and 5 P. M., it is our hope to complete the repaving of Indian Hill Road weather permitting by June 20, 2014. We ask that no cars be parked in the road during the construction times mentioned above. The roadway will be open to local traffic at all times during construction. Residents using Indian Hill Road may experience delays during completion of the project. Detours signs will be provided during construction activities to reduce traffic congestion during construction.

Dyer Cemetery Road:
