



Solarize Canton Now at Tier 3!

Our Solarize Canton program has hit Tier 3! As of the end of this week, almost ten residents have signed contracts to go solar. Greg Boyko's home is the site of the first Solarize Canton installation, which is going up this week. Mr. Boyko is installing 26 panels on his barn representing a 9.36 kW system covering almost 60% of his electricity needs. With rebates covering one third of his system, along with federal tax credits, Mr. Boyko expects to save over \$1,800 a year, an 11% return on his investment in the first year.

Remember that in order to participate in Solarize Canton, you must sign a contract by July 12th. Our open house on Friday, May 10th from 5-7 is a great way to learn more. Details can be found at www.solarizect.com/canton.
