What is a Community Emergency Response Team?

The CERT program educates residents about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area.

It trains them in basic disaster response skills such as (but not limited to): fire safety, light search and rescue, shelter operations, and disaster medical operations.

If a disaster happens (*Remember "Snow-tober" 2011?*) that overwhelms local response capability, CERT members step in and apply the training learned in the classroom to give critical support to their family, loved ones, neighbors, co-workers, and community.
