Rules:

- 1.) Eligibility: Open to all Canton residents.
- 2.) Photographs must be submitted by the photographer, or include written permission.
- 3.) All entries become the property of the Town of Canton Conservation Commission, with shared rights for unlimited reproduction in print, electronic publications and promotional materials for an unlimited period of time. Published photos will be given photo credit.
- 4.) You may submit up to 3 photographs.
- 5.) Entries can be submitted in either color or black and white, (jpeg. Format preferred and at least 300 dpi. Or greater).
- 6.) Each image submitted must include the photographer's name, address, and phone number, location and date of the picture, along with the specific category and a photo title (optional).
- 7.) Be prepared to provide the Canton Conservation Commission with written consent of anyone who appears in a photograph.
- 8.) Photos must be taken in the Town of Canton.
- 9.) The Canton Conservation Commission reserves the right to adjust any deadlines as the result of causes beyond its immediate control.
