

Town of Canton
November 4, 2014 State Election

The Electors of the Town of Canton are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller, Attorney General and Judge of Probate.
- II. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of a proposed amendment to the Constitution of Connecticut, a vote of "YES" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "NO" being a vote for disapproval:

"Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to remove restrictions concerning absentee ballots and to permit a person to vote without appearing at a polling place on the day of an election?"

The full text of such proposed questions with explanatory text, printed in accordance with §2-30a of the General Statutes, is available at the Town Clerk's office for public distribution. The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to the Constitution of Connecticut.

- III. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of a proposed resolution, a vote of "YES" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "NO" being a vote for disapproval:

"Shall the Town of Canton appropriate \$4,780,000 for acquisition of the site for and design, construction and equipping of a municipal highway garage; and authorize in issue of bonds and notes in the same amount to finance the appropriation?"

Pursuant to Sections 7-7, 9-369 and 9-369d of the General Statutes a Special Town Meeting held on October 22, 2014, was adjourned at its conclusion and submitted the resolution to referendum vote on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M., in conjunction with the election to be held on that date. Application for absentee ballots should be made to the Town Clerk's office. Electors and persons qualified to vote in town meetings who are not electors shall vote on this question at the following polling place: Canton Town Hall, 4 Market Street, Collinsville, Connecticut.

The complete text of the resolution to be presented is on file and available at the office of the Town Clerk for public inspection during regular business hours.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling place is as follows: 4 Market Street, Collinsville, CT. Absentee Ballots will also be counted at 4 Market Street, Collinsville, CT. Voting tabulators will be used. The polls will be opened at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
