

Transfer Station Summary – 2015

Hours of Operation:

Tuesday – Saturday, 7:00 am – 3:30 pm
(CLOSED Sun/Mon/Holidays)

Location:

Ramp Road – adjacent to Powder Mill Road, off Route 202

Eligibility for Use:

Canton RESIDENTS (non-commercial use) – see full policy for details

User Fees:

Annual Permit Vehicle Sticker – \$150 per household

- Unlimited trips, January 2015 – December 2015
- Everyday household trash, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present vehicle registration upon purchase
- *Additional stickers for vehicles registered to the same person/address - \$1*
- After April 1st, pro-rated fees are offered to new residents and residents who have suspended their private curb-side pick-up. See full policy for details

One-Day Use Pass – \$10

- Multiple trips
- Everyday household trash, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present proof of residency upon purchase

Bulky Waste – Annual Permit or One-Day Use Pass required, plus an additional fee based on the size of the load. Please note: *some items have a specific fee. See the Bulky Waste payment schedule for details.*

- Tokens, which are purchased in \$5 increments as proof of payment, are turned-in to the Transfer Station Attendant when dropping off Bulky Waste. Tokens can be purchased in any quantity, do not expire, and are non-refundable.
- Bulky Waste is: Oversized items that would not be considered regular “kitchen trash” or recycling (rugs, furniture, private household construction debris, etc.)
- *As of Sept. 2013 – Bulky Waste tokens and One-Day Use Passes may be purchased directly at the Transfer Station using a Credit Card or Personal Check*

E-Waste disposal – FREE for Canton residents

- No Permit or Pass required – Proof of Canton residency required
- Cell phones, computers, copiers, fax machines, iPods, PDAs, modems, monitors, printers, stereo & radio equipment, telephones, televisions, typewriters, video cassette recorders, keyboards, mouse, and batteries.

Christmas Trees – FREE for Canton residents Dec 26, 2014 – Jan 31, 2015

Where/How to Purchase:

Town Clerk’s Office – Canton Town Hall, corner of Main St. and Market St., Collinsville

- All Permits, Passes, and Bulky Waste Tokens
- Cash, Check, or Credit/Debit Accepted (2.95% or \$2 minimum convenience fee applied to credit/debit transactions)

Transfer Station – Ramp Road, off Powder Mill Road

- One-Day Use Passes and Bulky Waste Tokens
- Check or Credit/Debit only
- No Cash accepted at the Transfer Station

BULKY WASTE FEE SCHEDULE

a) Once a resident is permitted, there will be a fee charged based on the vehicle type at the time of each bulky waste drop-off. The schedule of type of vehicle and fees is as follows:

<u>Type of Vehicle</u>		<u>Disposal Fee</u>
Car		\$10
Station Wagon/Mini Van/Truck/SUV/Trailer	½ load	\$15
Station Wagon/Mini Van/Truck/SUV/Trailer	full load	\$30
Dump Truck	½ load	\$50
Dump Truck	full load	\$100

b) There will be a charge for individual items as follows:

White Goods <i>with Freon</i>	\$25 each
Mattresses or Box Springs (regardless of size)	\$30 each
Regular Tires	\$5 each
Truck Tires	\$15 each

c) There will be a charge for brush, limbs and leaves:

<u>Type of Vehicle</u>	<u>Disposal Fee</u>
Car and Minivan	\$5
Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer	\$10
Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck	\$20

*Between Dec 26 and Jan 31 Christmas trees can be dropped off free of charge

PLEASE NOTE: ONE DAY PASSES AND TOKENS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

Bulky waste and one-day use fees can now be paid for directly at the Transfer Station with either a personal check or a debit/credit card. Cash will not be accepted.

Recycling List

Single Stream Recycling

- Paper (newspapers, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, envelopes) – no bundling required!
- Clean cardboard and boxboard (cracker boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes and other similar materials) – no bundling required!
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Office and school papers
- Empty glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum cans and clean foil
- Empty tin and steel cans, including aerosol cans
- All plastic containers labeled #1 & #2
- All other plastic food, beverage, soap and shampoo containers labeled #3 - #7

Propane Tanks

We accept 20 lb tanks that typically come from your gas grills.

Scrap Metal

Aluminum, copper, brass, lead, electrical wires, cast iron & heavier steel

Waste motor oil & anti-freeze

White Goods *without Freon*

e-Waste Materials

(no permit sticker or token is required)
