**BOARD OF SELECTMEN RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CHARGE TO THE  
TEMPORARY SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION STUDY COMMITTEE**

The Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee was established Pursuant to Charter section 6.05 (I).

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CHARGE TO THE TEMPORARY SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION STUDY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee was created by vote of the Board of Selectmen on February 3, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee was established for a term ending February 3, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee was charged with "investigating and recommending to the Board changes in the operations and fee structure of the Solid Waste Transfer Station to promote increased recycling and to establish an equitable fee structure of usage of the station by residents"; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee presented a report to the Board of Selectmen on November 17, 2010 outlining its progress and recommendations on the charge given to it; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Selectmen is desirous of amending the charge previously given to the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Selectmen does hereby amend the charge to the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee by requesting the Committee review the following:

- 1) Review policies and procedures for E-Waste recycling so that the operations are consistent with the requirements of State Statute;
- 2) Review policies and procedures and impact on revenues of providing recycling to residents without a transfer station sticker;
- 3) Prepare and implement, after CAO review and approval, an educational outreach program describing the benefits of programs at the Transfer Station including but not limited e-waste and single stream recycling; and
- 4) Review and investigate the possibility of selling tokens at the Transfer Station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee shall coordinate it's recommendations and finding with town staff including but not limited to the Director of Public Works and the Project Administrator. The Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee shall periodically report back to the Board of Selectmen. The term of the Temporary Solid Waste Transfer Station Study Committee shall be until February 3, 2012.
