Commonly Installed Auxiliary Heating Appliance Requirements:

2022 Connecticut State Building Code

All appliances listed below require heating permit.

This includes a wood burning stove, pellet stove, wood fireplace inserts, gas log fireplace set, gas log insert, freestanding gas heater, or similar.

You must include with the permit application:

- 1. The appliance specifications
- 2. Installation instructions
- 3. A floor plan of the room or area (with the dimensions of that area)

All must be listed and labeled for the specific use, i.e., ASTM, UL, CA, or an approved listing agency.

All wood / pellet appliances – Heating permit

All gas appliances – Heating & plumbing permits (plumbing for gas supply piping)

NOTE: Freestanding chimneys and fireplaces require a separate building permit
