Location:

Ramp Road – adjacent to Powder Mill Road, off Route 202

Eligibility for Use:

Canton RESIDENTS (non-commercial use) – full policy details: <https://www.townofcantonct.org/transfer-station>

User Fees:

Annual Permit Vehicle Sticker – \$150 per household

- Unlimited trips, January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022
- Everyday household trash, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present vehicle registration upon purchase
- *Additional stickers for vehicles registered to the same person/address - \$5*
- After June 30th, only new residents and residents who provide proof of suspension of their private curbside pickup service qualify for pro-rated rates. Full policy for details (<https://www.townofcantonct.org/transfer-station>)

One-Day Use Pass – \$10

- Multiple trips
- Everyday household trash, all recycling, Swap-Shack usage
- Must present proof of residency upon purchase

Bulky Waste – Annual Permit or One-Day Use Pass required, plus an additional fee based on the size of the load. Please note: some items have a specific fee. See the Bulky Waste payment schedule for details.

- Tokens, which are purchased in \$5 increments as proof of payment, are turned-in to the Transfer Station Attendant when dropping off Bulky Waste. Tokens can be purchased in any quantity, do not expire, and are non-refundable.
- Bulky Waste is: Oversized items that would not be considered regular “kitchen trash” or recycling (rugs, furniture, private household construction debris, etc.)
- *Bulky Waste tokens and One-Day Use Passes may be purchased directly at the Transfer Station using a Credit Card or Personal Check*

E-Waste disposal – FREE for Canton residents

- No Permit or Token required – Proof of Canton residency required
- Cell phones, computers, copiers, fax machines, iPods, PDAs, modems, monitors, printers, stereo & radio equipment, telephones, televisions, typewriters, video cassette recorders, keyboards, mouse, batteries and light bulbs.

Clean Mattresses & Box Springs – FREE for Canton residents

- No Permit or Token required – Proof of Canton residency required

- All Permits, Passes, and Bulky Waste Tokens

Transfer Station – Ramp Road, off Powder Mill Road

- One-Day Use Passes and Bulky Waste Tokens
- Check or Credit/Debit only; No Cash accepted at the Transfer Station

BULKY WASTE FEE SCHEDULE

a) Once a resident is permitted, there will be a fee charged based on the vehicle type at the time of each bulky waste drop-off, load size will be determined by transfer station attendant. The schedule of type of vehicle and fees is as follows:

| <u>Type of Vehicle</u> | | <u>Disposal Fee</u> |
|---|-----------|---------------------|
| Car | | \$10 |
| Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer | ½ load | \$15 |
| Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer | full load | \$30 |
| Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck | ½ load | \$50 |
| Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck | full load | \$100 |

b) There will be a charge for individual items as follows:

c) There will be a charge for brush/logs:

| <u>Type of Vehicle</u> | <u>Brush Disposal Fee</u> | <u>Logs Disposal Fee</u> |
|---|---------------------------|--------------------------|
| Car | \$5 | \$10 |
| Mini Van, Pick-up and/or 8 Foot Trailer | \$10 | \$20 |
| Greater than 8 Foot Trailer and/or Dump Truck | \$20 | \$40 |

*Christmas trees can be dropped off free of charge thru Jan 29, 2022. Proof of Canton residency required.

Recycling List

Permit Sticker Needed:

Single Stream Recycling

- Paper (newspapers, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, envelopes) – no bundling required!
- Clean cardboard and boxboard (cracker boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes and other similar materials) – no bundling required!
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Office and school papers
- Empty glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum cans and clean foil
- Empty tin and steel cans, including aerosol cans
- All plastic containers labeled #1 & #2
- All other plastic food, beverage, soap and shampoo containers labeled #3 - #7

Propane Tanks

- We accept 20 lb tanks that typically come from your gas grills.

Scrap Metal

- Aluminum, copper, brass, lead, electrical wires, cast iron & heavier steel

White Goods with/without Freon

Waste motor oil & anti-freeze

Leaves
