The Farmington Board of Education provides courses in Adult Basic Education (ABE), Citizenship, High School Completion Courses (GED®, CDP & NEDP), and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESL). These courses are **FREE** to residents of Farmington, Unionville, Avon, Canton, Collinsville, Burlington, and Harwinton. Registration is required for ALL courses!

 ABE, ESL, GED® & Citizenship**

NATIONAL EXTERNAL DIPLOMA PROGRAM (NEDP)
 NEDP assists adults with life experiences, such as working and raising a family, towards a high school diploma. All work is done in a non-traditional, one-to-one at-home setting.

CREDIT DIPLOMA PROGRAM (CDP)
 For motivated, independent learners with a busy work schedule who have 4-7 credits left to earn a diploma. Made up of a combination of teacher-led courses and an internet-based high school curriculum. Earn credits through independent study projects, community service, work experience, or vocational training.
